



The Holly Heritage Farm Community Garden is located at 13409 N. Holly Road. There are 52 plots that each measure 10 x 25 feet. There is a 1200 gallon water tank (Donated by Mitchell Farms) that supplies water to the corner of every plot. Three foot wide paths pass by every plot, which will accommodate a walker or motorized scooter. The whole garden is enclosed in 7 foot wire fence with rabbit fencing at the bottom. This helps to keep the wildlife from eating the vegetables!

In 2013 48 of the 52 plots are available to lease. Four plots will be planted with sweet corn for all to share.
