



HOLLY AREA VETERANS' RESOURCE CENTER

The Holly Area Veterans' Resource Center is a non-profit 501(c)3 entity and it provides a variety of services to Veterans and their families. The Center was created because Holly is a distance from service offices and VA facilities. The Holly Area Veterans' Resource Center is located in Room C309 at the Karl Richter Community Center, 300 E. Street, Holly, MI. It is open every Tuesday and Wednesday from 9:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m. Oakland County Certified Service Officers are at the Center to handle claims and answer questions on the first and second Tuesday of the month. Since the Center began providing services in Holly, the clientele has been increasing steadily; many Veterans have received compensation. To make an appointment, call 248-858-0785 and ask for Lauren. "Walk-ins" are always welcome. Please bring your discharge papers (DD-214). If you cannot find them, come in and we will help you locate them.

The Center provides resources for Veterans and their families. Services include direct Veterans Administration resources and resources from local, state, and national organizations whose missions are to help Veterans. The Center also works with state and federal legislators on Veterans issues.

The Center sponsored two Vietnam War Veterans Pinnings in conjunction with Senate Floor Majority Leader Mike Kowall, Congressman Mike Bishop, Michigan Senator Dave Robertson, and others. The Center's Board of Directors consists of Veterans and non-Veterans. Everyone is a volunteer and we are always looking for volunteers.
